The National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC) is a portable credential that demonstrates achievement and a certain level of workplace employability skills in Applied Mathematics, Locating Information, and Reading for Information.

Assessments measure real-world skills that employers believe are critical to job success. Test questions are based on situations in the everyday work world.

The NCRC helps a job candidate:

- ✦ Demonstrate transferable employability skills to educator and employers
- ✦ Compare their work-readiness skill level to those required for jobs they want.

Once employers know an applicant's skill level, they can determine who will be a good fit for job openings. Registration required.
