Flexibility

Our online platform allows students to access their courses anytime, anywhere, providing the flexibility to create a personalized learning schedule that fits their individual needs.

- Synchronous contracts: Most of our students are on a synchronous contract which means they follow the same bell schedule of DMPS brick-and-mortar schools. Students must attend live classes from 8:30 AM- 3:30 PM on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, with breaks in between classes and a half hour for lunchtime.
- Asynchronous contracts: Students may qualify for an asynchronous contract which allows students to pace themselves through courses with pre-published online content and recorded lessons. All live lessons are filmed and stored for convenient access.
- Teachers are available virtually and in-person for individualized instruction and small group work.
- Students can set an online appointment with teachers via Microsoft Teams when help is needed.
 While teachers have office hours, they have been known to take calls nearly anytime, including weekends!

Multi-Level Supports

- We foster a supportive and inclusive learning environment where students can thrive. Our
 dedicated teachers are readily available to provide guidance, support, and constructive
 feedback, creating a collaborative atmosphere that encourages academic excellence.
- Beyond academics, we offer a range of virtual and in-person extracurricular activities, clubs, and events that allow students to explore their interests, develop leadership skills, and connect with their peers in supportive virtual and in-person communities.
- Students also have access to their home school's social and athletic teams, clubs, and activities.
- Wrap-around services are provided for students and families to ensure support with every barrier inside or outside of school. Examples include tutoring and basic needs.
- Free DART bus pass given with student IDs.
- Wi-fi and laptop computers are provided.
- Textbook and technology fees are only \$70.
