The goal of Strengthening Families Program: For Parents and Youth 10-14 is to prevent substance abuse in youth by building their skills and giving parents more tools to help their children become responsible young adults.

Groups of three trained facilitators are needed to conduct the program. One facilitator teaches the parent group, two facilitators teach the youth group, and all three facilitators work with families during the family session.

Facilitators should have

- strong presentation and facilitation skills
- experience working with parents and youth
